The Northern District of Iowa Branch of the Historical Society of the United States Courts in the 8th Circuit submits the following report of its activities and finances during the period July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014:

After several years of significant activity, the Branch has been quiet over the past year. The Committee's project that focused on the design and content of the Historical Center in the new Federal Courthouse in Cedar Rapids has resulted in a fully operational historical center in the new courthouse with audio visual displays of important persons, places, and cases. The exhibit was visited by over 500 guests the first day and continues to host, on a regular basis, school and civic groups. The Northern District of Iowa's website has recently been updated to include current photos of the History Center and provides online access to relevant materials for persons unable to personally visit the Center. Our branch expects to hold elections for new officers by September 1, 2014 and will continue its efforts to provide support to the Court in making available to the public relevant materials relating to the work of the Court.


