The sixth judicial oral history was completed since my last report. Stephen N. Limbaugh served as United States District Judge for the Eastern District of Missouri from July 21, 1983, until he retired on July 31, 2008. The video recording will be perpetually available for viewing in the Learning Center of the Thomas F. Eagleton Courthouse, along with other retired and Senior Judges William L. Hungate, John F. Nangle, Edward L. Filippine, William H. Webster and Donald J. Stohr.

The case of *Green v. McDonnell Douglas*, identified by the History Committee of the Eastern District of Missouri, as one of seventeen of the most significant cases ever decided in this District, will soon be in the Learning Center. All research has been completed, and filming of participating individuals will be completed this summer. Since my last report, recording of another of the seventeen cases, the Dred Scott case, was completed.

And Justice For All, a book on the history of the Eastern District of Missouri, will be published and distributed early this Fall. Dr. Burton Boxerman is the author.
