During 2012, the South Dakota Federal Courts Historical Society added two books to its collection: 1) History of the United States District Court for the District of South Dakota done in 1991 by Peggy J. Teslow, the Judicial Assistant to Judge B. Jones; and 2) A Judge's Journey, a recent biography of former U.S. Magistrate Judge Marshall P. Young. The South Dakota Federal Courts Historical Society also added to its collection DVDs of the Andrew W. Bogue Federal Building and U.S. Courthouse Naming Ceremony on August 19, 2011, and placed in DVD format VHS material including interviews of Judge Andrew Bogue and Judge Fred Nichol, district court judges who have passed away. Additional materials and photographs were added to the file for Judge Donald J. Porter, a district court judge who passed away in 2003.

The Society is sending examples of oral history interviews to those likely to conduct such interviews of the district's two senior status judges, Judge Lawrence L. Piersol and Judge Charles B. Kornmann, to create and preserve an oral history from those two judges.

The account for the South Dakota Federal Courts Historical Society was closed a number of years ago, so there are no funds on hand.
